23/12	1907	Eritrea	Decided to (i) impose an arms embargo on Eritrea; (ii) apply travel restrictions and an asset freeze to individuals and entities designated by the Committee on Somalia; (iii) call upon all Member States to inspect suspected cargo to and from Somalia and Eritrea; (iv) authorize all Member States to seize and dispose banned cargo to and from Eritrea; (v) expand the mandate of the Committee on Somalia; and (vi) expand the mandate of the Monitoring Group re-established by resolution 1853 (2008). 17/12	1904	Afghanistan	Decided to (i) adjust the financial sanctions measures to permit the addition to frozen accounts of any payment in favour of the listed individuals or groups provided that such payments were already subject to earlier measures (ii) authorise the establishment of an Office of the Ombudsperson for an initial period of 18 months to assist the Sanction Committee in its consideration of delisting requests, (iii) include measures to streamline the listing process of names and individuals and entities onto the Consolidated List, and (iv) extend the mandate of the current New York-based Monitoring Team for a further period of 18 months.	OCMFA's instruction is pending. Scope of application is being examined.
