13/10	1891	Sudan	Decided to extend the mandate of the Panel of Experts that helps monitor the arms embargo and sanctions until 15 Oct 2010, urged all States to supply any information at their disposal on the implementation of the embargo and the sanctions and encouraged all States, in particular those in the region, to report to the Committee on the actions taken to implement the measures imposed by UNSCR 1591(2005) and 1556(2004). 13/10	1892	Haiti	Decided to extend the mandate of the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti until 15 Oct 2010, adjusted its force configuration to better meet current requirements and invited Member States, including neighbouring and regional States, to strengthen their engagement with the Haiti Government to address cross-border illicit trafficking of persons, drugs, arms and other illegal activities. 12/6	1874	Democratic People's Republic of Korea	Condemned the 25 May nuclear test by the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK), decided to tighten sanctions against DPRK by blocking funding for nuclear, missile and proliferation activities, widening the ban on arms imports-exports and calling on Member States to inspect and destroy all banned cargo to and from DPRK.	OCMFA's instruction received. The preparation of the draft regulation is underway.
24/4	1718	Democratic People's Republic of Korea	Add the items contained in document S/2009/205 to the list of items subject to the arms embargo.	OCMFA's instruction received. The list will be incorporated into the amended regulation.
